Hole in One

Started 2013 with \$2057.00...New balance is \$2637.00 after expenditures.

Expenditures were:

Creighton Cup - \$60.00

Flowers for Ed Eckle's mother and sister - \$53.00 each

All 2012 scores have been dropped from the handicaps to compute the 2014 handicaps. 46 players have handicaps and 3 played one round. Cookie Campbell and Russ Jones must play one more to have an established handicap. George Geyer and Vince Christopher are on medicals and considered full handicap members. Dan Murray and Joe Tighe didn't play and will be assigned a handicap if they show, until 5 rounds are played. All players without an established handicap will fall under the rule of making the match even to be in the F/B/T bet.

There were 28 scheduled weeks in 2013 plus Zoar and The Creighton Memorial with 1 rainout. 8 golfers played 20 or more rounds, 14 played between 15 and 19 rounds, 10 played between 10 and 14 rounds, and 19 played 9 rounds or less for a total of 51 different participants. Of the 27 rounds played we had 3 rounds with 32 players, one with 31, 12 between 24 and 28, and 11 we had less than our allotted 24. The majors had turnouts of 25 @ The Masters, 25 at The Open, 32 @ The Creighton Cup, and 32 @ The Memorial.

New Business

1. Motion to raise the bet to \$20 per week

5. Motion to have Tom Tighe as a member of our league.

Unanimous approval. Motion passed.

6. Motion to change the Hole-in-one fee to a \$25 annual fee applicable to all current and returning past members prior to your first round of golf of the season. If the fee isn't paid before you tee off that round, you will not be eligible for the hole in one prize that day. The fee is \$50 for new members of the league. The extra \$1 weekly bet will now be paid out to the low net score with handicaps rounded to the nearest single digit and with ties being evenly divided up by the winners.

Finally, Rich requested that anyone planning on attending on any given Saturday notify him by Thursday of that week by phone or email that you will be attending that Saturday. This will allow him to notify the courses if our count is significantly different from the original number of times that he had requested. The number of players will not be capped, and no one refused if you reply by Thursday.
