Started 2014 with \$2637.00...New balance is \$3498.00 after expenditures. Expenditures were: Creighton Cup - \$60.00

All 2013 scores have been dropped from the handicaps to compute the 2015 handicaps. 44 players have established handicaps and 5 have assigned handicaps unti the requred number of rounds are posted. All players without an established handicap will fall under the rule of making the match even to be in the F/B/T bet per rule. They will be in the skins and CP's only.

There were 28 scheduled weeks in 2014 plus Zoar and The Creighton Memorial with 2 rainouts. 6 golfers played 20 or more rounds, 16 played between 15 and 19 rounds, 7 played between 10 and 14 rounds, and 20 played 9 rounds or less for a total of 49 different participants. Of the 26 rounds played we had 2 rounds with 30 players, 7 between 25 and 29, 10 between 20 and 24 and 7 between 12 and 18. The majors had turnouts of 30 @ The Masters, 18 @ The Open, 24 @ The Creighton Cup, and 30 @ The Memorial.
